The Kinsmen Pool Booking Report and the PMC & Pem-Ice II Booking Reports were provided for the information of the Committee. She explained that some minor tile and grout repair were scheduled to be done at the pool during the holidays, adding that if funds are available for further work the pool may have to be closed for a short period in order for the work to be done. Ms. Ellis noted also that the PMC is being used by many walkers.

With regard to Snospree, Ms. Ellis advised that information will be made available as events are finalized. Councillor Henderson asked how volunteers could get involved and Ms. Ellis advised that volunteers will be used as parking attendants, supervisors of outdoor play areas, at hot chocolate stands, etc.

Events will be held on February 4, 5, and 6, all on one weekend, with the waterfront as the main location for activities. The fishing derby is still not confirmed, due to ice conditions.
